The award was presented in front of over 300 tourism and hospitality professionals at the Awards for Excellence Gala Dinner, which took place at Aerospace Bristol on Thursday 6th February 2020.

A panel of independent judges - Susan Deer, ABTA; Patrick Richards, ETOA; and Dr. Karen Thomas, Canterbury Christ Church University - compiled the shortlist, based on self-nominations from member companies, with the final winners voted for by the membership.

Several factors were cited by the panel as having strongly contributed to Visit Kent's award win, including; successful engagement with inbound tour operators on two Discover England Fund projects (Gourmet Garden Trails of England, and England's Creative Coast), the launch of a brand-new travel trade resource hub, and the rollout of this year's event-led #KentyTwenty activity.

The Awards for Excellence were presented during the association's Annual Convention which took place at the Mercure Bristol Grand Hotel on Wednesday 5 and Thursday 6 February. The event featured an influential line-up of speakers including Twitter's former EMEA Vice President Bruce Daisley and Patricia Yates from VisitBritain/VisitEngland.
